




Everything you need for ease of operation and maximum control comes on the 43 Walkaround. These include access to electronics and controls at the tower station (above), an ergonomic helm on the bridgedeck (below), and a full Bausch tower (right). Nothing is left to chance, no box left unchecked. Just climb aboard and go fishing.












The 120-square-foot cockpit (left) provides many built-in features to make fishing easier, things like amply sized fish boxes, optimal gunwale heights, and a strategically placed chair/rocket launcher. Small things like stainless bow chocks and anti-chafe strips (above) simplify operation, and a transom live well (below) keeps live bait frisky and close at hand.



CONSTRUCTION

- Ablative/Copolymer anti-fouling bottom paint, two coats, primed
- Awlgrip engine-room, lazarette, forward bilge and anchor locker for enhanced visibility and easier maintenance
- Blister-resistant modified epoxy resin in entire hull skin
- Custom-blended modified vinylester resin used in structural laminates, topsides, bridges, and hardtops
- Dockside and overboard pump-outs for holding tank
- Satin interior finish throughout
- High-performance isophthalic gelcoat npg superior gloss, flexibility, and outstanding weathering characteristics
- Hull vacuum-infused using closed-cell foam cores with E-glass hybrid fiberglass laminates
- Hull interior isophthalic gelcoat topcoat with a durable high-gloss polyurethane coating
- Aluminum fuel tank and molded freshwater and holding tanks

- Nonskid for traction and durability
- Stringers fiberglass-encapsulated foam
- Composite bulkheads
- Air Conditioning direct expansion zoned with reverse-cycle heat for complete climate control throughout the interior and with individual temperature controls for staterooms and salon
- Bilge pumps with additional clean-out pumps on centerline linked into monitoring system and connected to switches for automatic and manual operation
- DC power-assist hydraulic steering
- "MVP" engine room ventilation system with supplies and discharge fans for proper fresh air supply and water intrusion suppression
- Fire-suppression system tied into main engine and generator ignition systems with override
- Fuel and oil lines, flexible, steel-reinforced
 USCG-approved aircraft type.
- Hour meters on main engines and generator
- Internal sea strainers for generator
- Oil-changing system, gear-type pump for main engines, transmissions, and generator
- PEX plumbing, freshwater system with manifold system shut off
- Deck pump-out fitting and direct overboard pump-out for holding tank
- DC pressurized freshwater system with ondeck freshwater fill and cockpit dockside supply inlet with pressure-reducing valve

We aren't in the business of building cookie-cutter boats. Being a semi-custom builder, Release offers owners a great deal of choice when outfitting their boats. From power options to tower configurations to the bridgedeck to the specifics of how you wish to equip your cockpit or your belowdecks arrangement, many possibilities are at your disposal to make your Release uniquely your own.



We got into the boat business because we wanted to build something different, something unique: Boats that honor the best boats of yesteryear by emulating the classic, timeless looks those boats pioneered: sweeping sheer lines, proud bows with just enough flare, and some tumblehome at the transom. Teak helm pods, single-lever controls, and spacious, functional cockpits—these are boats that look like they're going fast even when they're tied to the dock. Amidst all the sameness you see in marinas and at sea these days, our goal was to create something that stood out, that made people do a double-take and say, "What's that?"
