With wide, secure side decks and a flush layout, anglers can follow a fish from the transom to bow without missing a beat—no steps to trip on, no hesitation. It's the freedom of a center console, with the ride, protection, and onboard comfort of a convertible.

- Blister-resistant vinylester resin in entire hull skin
- Custom-blended modified epoxy and polyester resin used in structural laminates & topsides
- Dockside and overboard pump-outs
- DuPont high-gloss polyurethane boot stripe
- Satin cherry interior finish throughout (Options available)
- High-performance isophthalic gelcoat for superior gloss
- Hull constructed using Airex foam cores with Aramid and E-glass hybrid fiberglass laminates
- Hull interior gelcoat topcoat
- Aluminum fuel tanks and molded freshwater and holding tanks
- Molded fiberglass engineroom ceiling with core for acoustical and thermal insulation
- Stringers fiberglass encapsulated foam
- Vacuum-infused composite bulkhead
